The menace of predatory journals is escalating alarmingly in the last few years. To create awareness about the fake open access journals among researchers, a State Level Workshop was organized by the Research Committee and IQAC on 16.09.2016 with Dr.R.Sevukan, Head, Department of Library and Information Science, Pondicherry University as the resource person. He accentuated the risk factors while publishing an article, fidelity of a journal, impact factors, avoiding citations from such journals, selection of quality journal through journal selection tools for manuscript submission and the available websites to identify fake journals. The speaker expressed his discontent about the dilution in the field of research and also exhorted that a researcher should standardize the method of research and publication because the predatory journals are not only deceiving the authors but are also polluting the academic and scientific research world. 62 participants got benefited through this program.


"TOOLS TO REVITALIZE RESEARCH AND TEACHING"

The faculty from nearby three colleges participated in this symposium. In his presentation he explained the framework of a research proposal and proposal structure. He enlisted research funding websites and research support unit. The reason for rejection of research proposal is also explained. The resource person also mentioned some strategies like publications, partnering, and networking and to develop a national reputation and to recognize an opportunity. About **50** participants were benefitted in this symposium. The profound information shared by the resource person gave a new dimension towards research for the scholars.

Session – 2: “Research Publications – Citation Analysis”

Dr. S. Shankar, Associate Professor, Department of Mechatronics Engineering, Kongu Engineering College, Perundurai delivered a speech on “Research Publications – Citation Analysis” In his talk he explained about Parameters & Weightage of our institute for NIRF ranking. He provided ample information regarding citation analysis in Google scholar profile which was an eye opener for the participants. He also listed some major indexed journal like

Scopus, SCI, Pubmed, Google scholar etc, for the publication of the research findings. He focussed on the Plagiarism norms that are followed in universities. He stressed the importance of brainstorming for getting new ideas and selection of research problem. The deliverance of the resource person was of great potential in adding knowledge on the undiscovered aspects of citation analysis. About 50 participants were benefitted through this symposium.

Madame Curie Webinar Initiative - Series II

(06.11.2020 - 12.11.2020)

REPORT

A Research Committee is functioning in the College to co-ordinate and support the research initiatives of the students and faculty. "Research Scholars Circle" was initiated in the Institution on 27.02.2020 to augment the quality of the research. The Research Conclave and Research Scholars Circle jointly organized six days "Madame Curie Webinar Initiative – SERIES - II" from 06.11.2020 to 12.11.2020.

The webinar titled "Exploiting Digital Information for Current Research" commenced on 6th November 2020. The resource person, **Dr. Pit. Pichappan**, Senior Scientist, Digital Information Research Labs, Chennai, has the credit of being a Guest Professor of Zhejiang University, China initiated the webinar series. Topics covered in this webinar include a method of tracking information digitally for research, searching techniques and research information from journal articles from the researcher's perspective. The invited speaker also detailed some major lists of libraries for e-resources. Searching techniques like Google Search and Academic Search are briefed. He gave insights about Springer, Science Direct, PubMed and Database maintenance. Presentation includes issues and challenges on the utilization of information and dark web page. The session concluded with a discussion between the speaker and participants on digital information for current research. The session was completed at around 4:30 p.m.

The webinar titled "Basics of Statistical tools" was the second session conducted on 7th November 2020. A welcome address was given by Dr. V. Sreeja, Assistant professor, Department of Chemistry. The session was handled by **Dr. R. Parvathi**, Associate Professor and

Head, Department of Mathematics, Vellalar College for Women, Erode. The lecture started with a motivational speech. She has provided a very clear presentation regarding different tools in statistics like measures of central tendency, measures of dispersions, correlation and regression. She explained various aspects of research methodology like the framework of hypothesis, data collection, data analysis, sampling procedure, etc. She also discussed the tools applied to various disciplines. Finally, the session ends with a mutual discussion.


The program for the Third day (9.11.2020) began as per the schedule with the prayer song. The well-organized team of the English Department elegantly led the program. The welcome note was given by Miss. M. Sivamani followed by the introduction of chief guest **Dr. S. Akila**, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science, Vellalar College for Women, Erode. The first and foremost instruction of the speaker was to record the findings of the researchers. The popular research writing tools such as Google Scholar, Grammarly, Ginger, Smallseotools and their usage were explained with detailed PowerPoint slides. To improve the language and to rectify the grammatical errors, two powerful tools Grammarly and Ginger application usage was demonstrated by the speaker to the research scholars. The installation of software for grammar check was vividly picturized to the listeners. Finally, the most important topic of discussion was on Plagiarism Check and the clarification regarding the topic was given importance by the speaker. Then the program came to an end with the discussion session followed by the vote of thanks. With **103 participants**, the program was very successful and productive.

The webinar titled “An Overview of Indian Banking Sector & Opportunities in it” was the third session conducted on **10.11. 2020**. The resource person **Mr.C. K. M.Soundar**, Senior Manager, Axis Bank, Coimbatore who has a banking career of almost 10 years, presented the basic Banking structure and its functioning along with the emerging trends in banking practices. He also highlighted the opportunities in the Banking sector and gave valuable insights on the online economic transactions initiated through private-owned applications. The programme saw a participation of **57** members from various streams and ended with the active interaction, queries effectively answered by the speaker.

The resource person for the Fifth session on **11.11.2020** was **Dr. R. Parvathi**, Associate Professor and Head, Department of Mathematics, Vellalar College for Women, Erode. In her speech on “SPSS for Researchers”, she discussed the advanced analysis and inference writing on

each aspect. She gave training on how to use SPSS software. Also, how to perform analysis in SPSS and writing interpretation according to our results were discussed. She also shared various tips regarding publishing papers in SCI-indexed journals and aspects to be improved by the scholars while they prefer to publish a paper in those journals. **53 members** participated and got benefited.

The Sixth session on **12.11.2020** was titled "Get Rid of Thorns from your Doctoral Journey". **Mrs. V. Sijina**, Ph.D. Research scholar, Department of Zoology, Kongunadu Arts and Science College, Coimbatore acted as resource person. She discussed various obstacles that are involved in performing research, ways of maintaining a friendly relationship with the members in the department, the importance of collaboration with other departments and steps to overcome the obstacles. **32 Research Scholars** from various streams participated and ended with the active interaction.
