The Board has approved the course content, scheme of Examinations and credit points allotted to various papers for M.Sc. Botany.

The detailed syllabuses for different papers are prepared and approved by the members of the Board. The question pattern for M.Sc theory and practicals has been approved by the members of the Board.

The following modifications are suggested by the Board members and the changes are incorporated in the syllabus as decided by the PE Board members.

1. In core paper I in Semester I scale up of fermentations, increasing product yields, are introduced instead of waste treatment.
2. Core papers II, III and IV in Semester I are revised.
3. In core papers V, VI and VII, the topics, polyembryony, meristem and suspension culture, and sex limited characters are introduced respectively.
4. In core paper VIII, the families such as Fabaceae, Rosaceae, Aristolochiaceae, and modern trends in taxonomy have been introduced instead of Combrataceae and sources of taxonomic information.
5. Core papers IX, X SBS II and III have <sup>been</sup> revised.
6. Core papers XI, XII, XIII in semester IV are revised by introducing certain topics.
7. Core Practicals I, II, III and IV have been revised.
