The Memorandum either directly or indirectly will not confer any right on any partner or volunteer to claim any amount from CII either suffered on account of any accident or loss caused because of any activity or on any account."

Both parties hereby agree that the terms and conditions for the above individual activities shall be mutually agreed and reviewed and updated from time to time. This Agreement will be in force for an initial period of one year and may be extended for further periods before the expiry of this Agreement. This agreement shall become effective from today, the 10th July, 2019 upon signing of this agreement.

The awareness on basic aspects of Chemistry to be utilised in business projects was exhorted and practically demonstrated by Dr.S.Manonmani, Associate Professor and Head, Department of Chemistry P.S.G arts and Science College, Coimbatore and Dr.M.Hema, Assiatant Professor of Chemistry, P.S.G arts and Science College, Coimbatore.

The Live demonstrations were carried out in the Major Chemistry Lab. The participants split into groups learnt the preparation processes effectively and interacted with the Resource persons. The details of preparations of Homemade soap, Phenoyl, Soap oil, Sunscreen lotion, Pain balm, Moisturiser cream and Candles were provided to the students and they were given hands on training.

Feedback from the enthusiastic participants was obtained. A total number of 55 students attended the programme which includes 8 students from the Entrepreneurship development programme.

WORKSHOP ON "MICROSCALE EXPERIMENTS IN CHEMISTRY"

21.01.2016

A one day workshop on "MICROSCALE EXPERIMENTS IN CHEMISTRY" funded by DBT-STAR College Scheme was conducted on 21st January 2016. Dr.S.Murugan, H.O.D of Chemistry (Rtd), S.T Hindu college, Nagerkoil demonstrated the experiments involved in the Inorganic Analysis and Organic Analysis in microscale. Faculty of the department, faculty from other departments and the students of B.Sc Chemistry participated and were benefited. The relevance of the technique was explained in the first session by a powerpoint presentation.

In the Technical session –I, Microscale Inorganic Analysis comprising volumetric analysis by two burette method, qualitative analysis of inorganic mixtures were demonstrated. In the session II, the organic analysis was demonstrated and micro technique of determination of melting points and boiling points was also demonstrated. He also exhorted the Lab Assistants on the preparation of various solutions for conduct of Microscale experiments. Dr.Murugan suggested that the microscale techniques be introduced into the curriculum.

Microscale technique is an environmentally safe pollution prevention method of performing chemical processes using small quantities of chemicals without compromising the quality and standard. It also reduces the running cost of the laboratory, the time required to perform experiments, chemical waste produced at the source. This technique offer more laboratory safety by decreasing the potential for exposure to chemicals. Due to the greatly reduced volumes of solvents & other volatile substances used, it improves the air quality and creates a pleasant working atmosphere. This ecologically sound technique

encourages 129 students of B.Sc Chemistry to think about waste minimization which creates the sense of "green chemistry". Three faculty members of Physics attended the programme.

The programme was interactive and participatory. Xerox copies of guidelines for carrying out the microscale experiments were distributed to the partricipants.

Dr.S.Murugan, H.O.D of Chemistry (Rtd), S.T Hindu College, Nagerkoil demonstrated the microscale experiments in the one day workshop on "Microscale experiments in chemistry" on 21.01.16
