Whereas

- A. Details of the implementation of any particular student exchange or faculty-related activity resulting from this Memorandum of Understanding shall be negotiated between the two (2) institutions as such specific case may arise and will be outlined in a Supplementary Student Exchange Agreement or Faculty Exchange Agreement between the institutions. Supplementary Agreements are subject always to availability of sufficient funds to the respective institutions.
- B. This Memorandum of Understanding reflects the respective institutions' commitments to both educational and academic exchanges as of the date of the Memorandum of Understanding. This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended or terminated at any time by either party provided that notice of termination or amendment is provided by the notifying party to the other

party within thirty (30) days of the date on which the termination or the amendment is intended to become effective. Any amendment or termination shall not have effect on any arrangement in place at the time that the notice is provided, where the arrangement arises from any Supplementary Agreements resulting from this Memorandum of Understanding.

Both institutions subscribe to the policy of equal opportunity and will not discriminate on the basis of gender, age, disability, race, color, religion, marital status, veteran's status, national or ethnic origin, or sexual orientation.

This Memorandum of Agreement will become effective immediately. It shall continue in effect for a period of five (5) years and may be extended by mutual agreement. It may be terminated by either institution upon one month written notification to the partner institution.

- 5. ACETECH shall decide on the number of faculty/supporting staff required for smooth conduct of classes.
- 6. ACETECH shall conduct classes on the specified Software courses at present.
- 7. Vellalar College for Women to enroll the number of students considering the availability of number of computers and allot one computer exclusively for each student for practical
- 8. ACETECH shall maintain necessary records of the student for conduct of training.

- 9. Vellalar College for Women shall provide congenial working atmosphere.
- 10. Vellalar College for Women shall appoint a co-coordinator to coordinate with ACETECH for smooth conduct of the training and render necessary assistance.
- 11. ACETECH shall not entertain any transfer / change of course by the students unless it is authorized by Vellalar College for Women with valid reason within the time frame of the training.





- 11.3 In case of insolvency, bankruptcy or liquidation of any party, the other party may terminate this Agreement by giving 30 (thirty) days written notice.
- 11.4 In case of breach of any terms and conditions by either party, the other party may terminate this agreement by giving 30 (thirty) days prior written notice, if the breaching party fails to remedy the alleged breach within 30 (thirty) days from the date the affected party notifies the breaching party of the problem.

15. COVENANTS

- 15.1 Both the parties hereby jointly covenant that both of them shall employ their reasonable endeavors and co operate with each other to discharge their respective obligations under this agreement.
- 15.2 Within the validity of this agreement each Party shall not discuss or enter into any relationship with any other third party except otherwise stated in this Agreement without the written consent of the other party.

16. FORCE MAJEURE

- 16.1 If any event of force majeure continues for a period in excess of ninety (90) consecutive days, resulting in the inability of a party to perform its business activities under the terms of this agreement, either party shall be entitled to terminate this Agreement upon written notice. In this case there will be no liability on either party.
- 16.2 The term force majeure used above shall mean acts of God, acts of any public enemy, wars, hartals, blockades, insurrections, riots, epidemics, landslides, lightening, earthquake, fires, storms, floods, civil disturbances, terrorisms and any other cause not within the control of the affected party; all of which by the exercise of due diligence such party is unable to prevent.

17. NOTICE

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- 17.1 All notices, documents, consents approvals and other communications to be given hereunder shall be in writing and be delivered by hand or transmitted by prepaid registered or recorded delivery mail or by facsimile in a form generating a record copy to the Parties and at the registered office address as described in the particulars of the Parties hereinbefore or any other address as may be designated afterwards by the parties.
- 17.2 Any notice sent by facsimile or other electronic means shall be deemed to have been duly served at the time of transmission.

18. GOVERNING LAWS AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION
