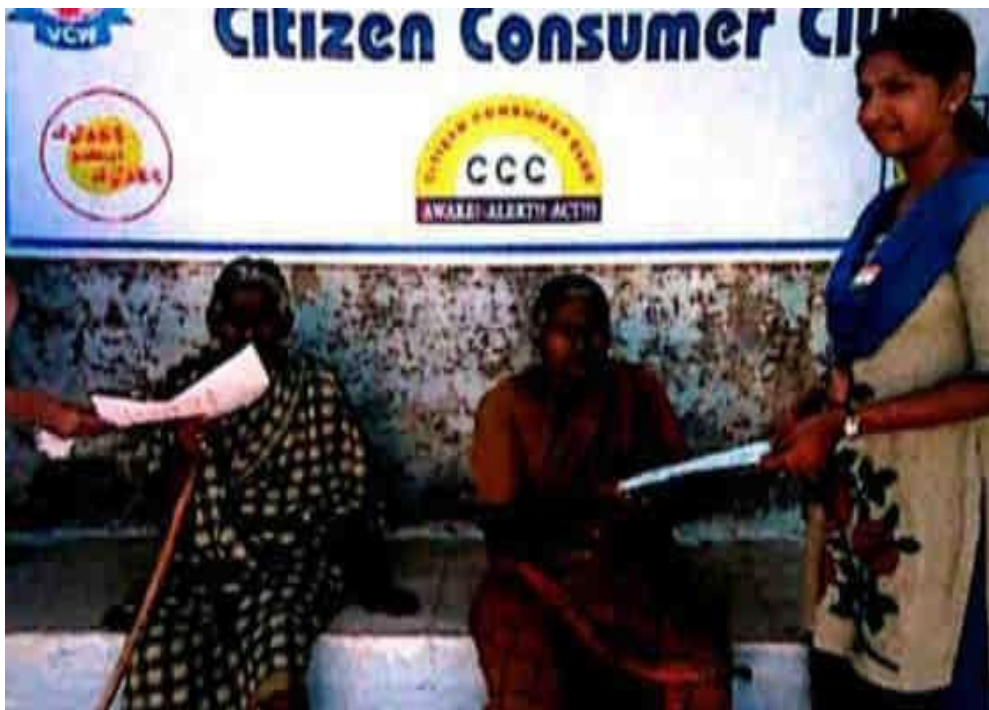


Name of the Activity: Consumer Rights Awareness Programme

They prepared seed balls using the methodology of natural farming with the materials like fresh cowdung, clay soil, red soil and many seeds like neem seeds, tamarind seeds, pomegranate seeds etc.,.
