The Board has approved the course content,  
scheme of Examinations and credit points allotted  
to various papers for B.Sc. Botany 2016-17 onwards

The Board of Studies resolved to revise all theory and practicals of Core and Electives, theory papers of Skill based subjects and Non major electives.

The revision of B.Sc. Botany syllabus has been framed by the Department which was discussed in the Board of studies and finalised with minor modifications as demand by the current trends.

The same has been approved by the Board of Studies for the Academic year 2016-17 batch onwards.

The Board of studies approved the syllabus with the following suggestions:

1. The Core Paper I to XII, Elective I & II, SBS I, III and IV and Non-major Elective I & II are updated for the students admitted from 2016-17 batch onwards.
2. The Core Practicals I to IV are also revised with the respective modification of theory syllabus.
3. The Elective Practical is modified as per the requirement of potential skill in Microbiology and Bioinformatics.
4. The SBS I and III are merged together as SBS Paper I Herbs and Health. Instead in the V<sup>th</sup> Semester a new SBS Paper III is introduced as Organic Farming which provides more self employment opportunities.

5. UGC sponsored career-oriented programme.
