Resolutions:

The following recommendations are suggested:

1. The syllabus for PG II Year (2018-19 batch) has been revised as per OBE pattern. The existing syllabi of 2018-19 batch has been approved by the board without any modifications and the same is to be followed to the 2019-20 batch.
2. It has been resolved to introduce an Inter-Disciplinary Course by the PG and Research Departments of English and History on "History through Literature" to the Students of M.A., English and M.A., History for SBS Paper II instead of the paper 'Travel Management' from 2018-19 batch onwards to hone the Inter-Disciplinary Skills of the Students.
3. In PG Non-Major Elective Paper I 'Hospitality Management in Tourism' in Unit-I, a new chapter 'Definition of Hospitality' has been included.

4. In SBS paper II "Tourism Resources in India" in Unit-IV, a new Chapter on 'Thanjavur' has been included.
5. As per UGC recommendations, it was decided to introduce MOOCs under Self learning category in Semester-II.
6. It has been resolved to follow the existing Question Paper pattern to the Students admitted in the year 2019-2020.

It is resolved to pass the Syllabi of M.A History Course to be followed from 2019-2020 onwards with the above said changes.
