Agreement between Vellalar College for Women (Autonomous) (VCW), Erode, TN & Spoken Tutorials (ST), IIT Bombay

We are happy to announce the collaboration between Vellalar College for Women (Autonomous), Erode, Tamil Nadu and IIT Bombay Spoken Tutorial program. From the day of agreement Vellalar College for Women (Autonomous), Erode will function as Spoken Tutorial IIT Bombay's Nodal Resource Centre (NRC) for Erode Region. As an NRC, Vellalar College for Women (Autonomous), will Nurture and spread awareness among the Colleges in Erode and surrounding districts (Salem, Namakkal, Dharmapuri, Krishnagiri, Ariyalur, etc). The entire program will be handled from Spoken Tutorial Team. The Spoken Tutorial activity is funded by the National Mission on Education through ICT, MHRD, Government of India at IIT Bombay.

As a part of agreement,

Vellalar College for Women (Autonomous), Erode, Tamil Nadu will -

- Identify a Chief Coordinator from the College who will actively work and co-ordinate with Spoken Tutorial team, IIT Bombay to roll-out and introduce the program.
- Put up the signed agreement note on the Vellalar College for Women (Autonomous), Erode website along with Spoken Tutorial site link along with Tamil Nadu's manager's contact details.
- Setting up a NRC team of Faculty Organisers & student volunteers to facilitate the Training session / workshops at its own premises and other colleges.
- Identify a group of minimum 10 Colleges (cluster) whom you will guide and nurture to introduce and systematically conduct Spoken Tutorial activities at their premises.
- Issuing notifications to College Principal(s) in surrounding Institutions to introduce and roll out the Spoken Tutorial Open Source software training in colleges immediately after the NRC is set up.
- Submit a periodic (monthly) status on the progress made, to the Spoken Tutorial team.
- Hold a Faculty Awareness Event in 2017 for Principals & faculty from colleges in Tamil Nadu & if possible in other states. (February / March 2017)
- Incorporate the relevant FOSS series Tutorials in the course-curriculum of Vellalar College for Women (Autonomous), Erode and motivate other colleges to do the same in their time-tables, wherever feasible.

As a Partner, the Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay will -

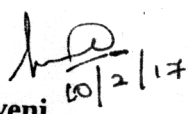
- Work as a mentor for Vellalar College for Women (Autonomous), Erode, Tamil Nadu.

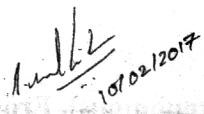

Roles and Responsibilities of the Nodal Centers

Responsibility

Activities/ Features

OVERALL ROLE

Principal to appoint

- 1 Nodal Faculty Officer/ Organiser,
- 1-2 representative Faculty Organisers (FO) related to Comp.Sc./MCA/IT and
- 1-2 Student volunteers –
- the "NC team"

OVERALL ACTIVITIES

- The NC team will work to -
 - Start the training immediately in select depts.,
 - Send the time-tables from different depts., for mapping to IITB, ST team,
 - Later on - Organise awareness workshops for district colleges

Faculty Organisers will start the training first in one dept. focussing on final year students

This can be done in this calendar year and definitely in the coming even Jan 2017 semester, so that graduating students can leave with at least 2-3 software skills and certificates. (by Mar 31st)

Each FO will -

- Register on the ST website,
- Select LibreOffice as the first software course
- Download and install the course in the systems (lab + laptops), if adequate systems not there
- Enroll the students in a Master Batch into the ST website.

Nodal Faculty Officer to oversee deployment of Spoken Tutorial courses in lab time-tables & syllabus

The time-tables will be sent to the ST, IITB state Training Coordinator who will map the lab hours with suitable fit ST software courses.

The college depts., will put these courses in print in the time-tables so that it becomes a permanent feature.

The Chief Faculty Coordinator will organise awareness programs & workshops for other colleges in the

district

The first of these will be done by Jan 2017

The ST,IITB team will send leaflets, brochures etc. For these workshops and also guide with ppts, videos etc. On how they can be conducted.

Skype facility can also be used to connect with IITB during the event.

The College will provide its lab facilities to colleges who may not have adequate infrastructure

The college can lend its premises and lab facilities to colleges which do not have sufficient systems or internet.
