Vellalar College for Women (VCW) is perhaps the only educational institution in the state to start the VCW Staff and Students Co-op Stores Ltd in 1972, College principal D Kannalaveni is the elected president of the store. She told Express that the BCom Hob, It Shauthi, is the vice-president of the stores and she, with the support of students and lecturers of her department, has been managing the store effectively for many years.

The store got a state-level best store award of the government in 2004-05 and district-level awards in 2005-06, 2006-07 and 2008-09.

ics, toiletries, greeting cards etc. for the students, including those stuying in hostels. Compared to the open market price, the price at the store is nearly to per cent less. If the students seek, the store also helps them get textbooks.


Students themselves manage the accounts and all other affairs of the store under the guidance of faculty members of Shanthi's department. It is not only a practical experience for them but also encourages them to strengthen the co-op movement in their areas, she boned.

College secretary S D Chandrasekaran said that co-operation is a fairly new concept which emerged in London in the 19th century. It is an alternative to both capitalism and socialism. The first co-operative institution in India came up in Thirur in Thiruvallur district in 1906.


