Dr. N. Maragatham, Principal and Chairperson of the meeting welcomed all the members present. The Board of Studies of different boards were conducted on 15.03.2019 and 22.03.2019. All the UG and PG boards are following the OBE pattern for the students admitted from 2018-19 and onwards. The Chairpersons of all the Boards have presented the Programme Outcomes and Syllabi of their respective departments which were approved in their BOS meetings. Few boards have decided to revise some of the courses for the UG & PG students admitted in 2019-20 and onwards.

* All the Boards have decided to follow the previous year question paper pattern for Continuous Internal Assessment, Model and End Semester Examination based on Blooms Taxonomy.

* UG board of History has changed the Question Paper Pattern for Core, Elective and Allied Papers as follows, for Section A as compulsory 10x1 = 10 marks with 5 questions as MCQ and 5 Fill Ups. The pattern of Section B as 2x10 = 20 marks.

Pattern with $5 \times 5 = 25$ marks and Section C as answer any FIVE out of Eight Questions with $5 \times 8 = 40$ marks. The board has also approved the revised panel of Question Papers, Setters and Examiners for Valuation.

- * PG Board of Mathematics has revised the question paper pattern for Skill Based Subject III as follows:

Section A	20x1 = 20 marks
Section B (either OR)	$5 \times 5 = 25$
Section C (Open choice 3 out of 5)	$3 \times 10 = 30$
TOTAL	75

- * UG Board of Commerce has changed the Question Paper Pattern for Core, Elective and Allied Papers resolved with objective type in Section A comprising FIVE multiple choice questions and FIVE True or False statements carrying 1 mark each replacing the existing pattern (Section A: $5 \times 2 = 10$ marks) for students admitted during the academic year 2018-2019 and onwards with effect from 2019-20.

- * As per UGC recommendations MOOCs have been introduced from the academic year 2019-2020 onwards for all UG and PG courses as "Non Ranking Compulsory Credits" to obtain degree.

It was resolved to ratify the recommendations of various Boards.

TAMIL:

UG - The course for the II semester of Part I Tamil is revamped by removing certain titles for the students admitted 2018-19 and onwards, and the courses for III and IV semester of Part I Tamil is framed according to OBE Pattern. The III and IV semester Core papers are framed as per OBE pattern.

HINDI:

No change.

ENGLISH:

UG - In Semester III - Fiction has been restructured, History of English Literature has been shifted to Semester III. Shakespeare I and II has been clubbed and introduced in Semester IV.

PG - In Semester III - Literary Criticism and Theory and History through Literature as an interdisciplinary course have been introduced. Research Methodology is titled as Research Methodology: Gateway to Structural Writing. New Literatures, Contemporary Literary Theory, Children's Literature and Project Viva-voce Examination have been introduced as new papers in Semester IV as per UGC recommendations.

HISTORY:

UG - The courses for III and IV semesters of

II year UG has been revised as per OBE Pattern for 2018-19 and onwards. In Non-Major Elective Paper I, a chapter 'Mahajanapadas' is included in Unit II, and the topic 'Indian Constitution' is replaced as 'Framing of Indian Constitution' of History for Competitive Examination. In Non-Major Elective Paper-II, a new chapter 'Indian National Army' is included in Unit-IV of Freedom Movement in India. In SBS-I, Multi Skill Development Paper, a topic on 'Time Management' has been added in Unit-iv. As per the UGC recommendations, in II Semester, MOOC is introduced under Self Learning Category. The syllabus of UGC approved Career Oriented Add. On Certificate / Diploma and Advanced Diploma Course on "Tourism and Hospitality Management" have also been revised.

PG - The syllabus for III and IV semesters of PG History has been revised as per OBE Pattern from students admitted from 2018-19 and onwards. For SBS Paper II, "Travel Management" has been replaced and resolved by introducing an Inter-Disciplinary Course as "History through Literature" and effective from 2018-2019 batch onwards. In Non-major Elective Paper I "Hospitality Management in Tourism" in Unit I, a new chapter 'Definition of Hospitality' has been included. In SBS Paper III "Tourism Resources in India" a new chapter on 'Thanjavur' has been included in Unit IV. As per UGC recommendations, MOOCs is

introduced under Self Learning Category in II Semester.

ECONOMICS:

Resolved to approve the revised syllabi of Allied papers, 'Agricultural Economy of India' and 'Economic Analysis' for B.Com. course and Allied papers, 'Indian Economic Development - I' and 'Indian Economic Development - II' for B.A. (History) Course and that the revised syllabi will come into force for the students admitted from the academic year 2018-2019 and onwards.

MATHEMATICS & MATHEMATICS (CA):

UG - Allied I - Mathematical Statistics - I (18MCVA101) theory paper is splitted into Allied-I Statistics for Mathematics - I (18MCVA101) - Theory and Allied Practical - Mathematical Software - I (18MCVAP01). Core paper IV - Trigonometry and Vector Analysis (18MCVC204) is splitted into Core Paper IV - Trigonometry, Vector Analysis and Fourier Series (18MCVC204) - Theory and Core practical - Mathematical Software - II (18MCVCP01). Allied - I - Mathematical Statistics - II (18MCVA202) is revised and changed into Allied-I- Statistics for Mathematics - II (18MCVA202) for the students admitted from 2018-19 and onwards.

PG - OBE pattern is followed for the syllabi and scheme of examinations for M.Sc.

Mathematics courses offered in Semester III & IV for the students to be admitted during the academic year 2018-19 and onwards.

Pleasure Theory and Integration (18MSPC309) is introduced instead of Fluid Dynamics (15MSPC415) and the Skill Based Subject III MA7LAB (11MSPS303) is replaced as Problems Solving in Algebra and Real Analysis (18MSPS305).

PHYSICS:

UG - The syllabi for core papers and Allied Physics papers for Semesters II and IV are revised. Skill based subject for semester VI, Add-on course on Information and Communication Technology for Semesters I & II and Self learning paper applicable to I, II and III year students are changed and the same is approved by the board and is applicable from the year 2019 and onwards.

PG - The syllabi for core papers, Elective paper for semester III and IV and the project for semester I are revised and is approved by the board for the students admitted during 2018-2019 and onwards.

CHEMISTRY:

UG - Core papers V and VI of B.Sc., Chemistry pertaining to Semester 3 and 4 respectively have been changed to OBE pattern with revised syllabus [18CHVC305 and 18CHVC406] for the students admitted in

2018-19 and onwards. Core practical II has been changed to OBE pattern with code number 18CHUCP02 for the students admitted in 2018-19 and onwards. Nonmajor Elective I and II in 3rd and 4th semesters [18CHUN301 and 18CHUN402] and Skill based Subjects I [18CHUC301] and Multiskill paper [18CHUS402] in 3rd and 4th semester respectively were revised for the students admitted in 2018-19 and onwards.

BOTANY:

UG - The detailed syllabi for Core Paper III and IV and Skill Based Subject I & II and Non-major Elective I & II have been revised.

PG - Outcome Based Education (OBE) pattern was also approved by the Board and Skill Based Subjects with slight modification for the students admitted from the academic year 2018-2019 and onwards. The detailed syllabi for Core Papers VII to XII and Skill Based Subject II and III have been revised.

ZOOLOGY:

Implemented OBE pattern for Core Papers - IV, V and Practical - II in the third and fourth semesters for the students admitted during 2018-19 onwards. Resolved to approve the revised syllabi of Skill Based Subject - I - Ornamental Fish Culture and Non Major - I - Wildlife Diversity and Conservation in Semester III and Skill Based Subject - II - Multi Skill Development

Paper and Non Major II - Public Health and Hygiene in Semester IV for the students admitted during 2018-2019. Resolved to approve the revised syllabi of UGC sponsored Add-On Course - Biomedical Instrumentation - Certificate course for the students admitted during 2019-2020 and onwards.

NUTRITION AND DIETETICS:

Implemented OBE pattern with following amendments.

The Core Practical IV Food Analysis & Quality Control is shifted from Semester IV to Semester VI [18NDUCPO4 to 18NDUCPO6]. The Core Practical V - International Cuisine is shifted from Semester V to Semester IV [18NDUCPO5 to 18NDUCPO4]. The Core Practical VI - Food Preservation is shifted from Semester VI to Semester V [18NDUCPO6 to 18NDUCPO5].

In Semester V, Part IV, Skill Based Subject III - Food Processing [18NDUS503] has been renamed as Food Processing and Preservation.

COMPUTER SCIENCE:

UG - The following courses are introduced with OBE pattern for semester III and IV for the students admitted during 2018-19 and onwards.

B.Sc. COMPUTER SCIENCE:

Introducing hands-on training using

an accounting package in "Business Accounting [15CSUA404]", has been changed with the new code [18CSUA303] and also mutually shifted with the paper "Operation Research [15CSUA303] with new code [18CSUA404]. "Microprocessor and its Applications" [15CSUC306] has been replaced with "Internet of Things [18CSUC306]". Revised the contents of "Object Oriented Programming with JAVA [18CSUC305]" and "Relational Database Management Systems [18CSUC407]".

BCA:

Introducing hands-on training using an accounting package in "Business Accounting [15CAUA303]", has been changed with the new code [18CAUA303]. Revised the contents of "Object Oriented Programming with JAVA [18CAUC305]" and "Relational Database Management Systems [18CAUC407]".

B.Sc., COMPUTER TECHNOLOGY:

C#.Net Programming [18CTUC408] and C#.Net Programming lab [18CTUCPO4] is introduced instead of GUI design tools [11CTUC408] and GUI design lab [11CTUCPO4]. Revised the contents of "Relational Database Management Systems [18CTUC304]".

by "Machine Learning Techniques - 18CSPC310", the Elective paper "Network Security - 11CSPE312" is replaced by "Information Security - 18CSPE312" and the content of "Web Designing Lab - 16CSPP03" has been revised and coded as "18CSPP03"

PG/DCA - Resolved to follow the revised syllabi for students admitted from 2019-2020 and onwards, the core paper "Web Designing - 18DCPC205" is replaced by "Web Programming - 19DCPC205" and "Web Designing Lab - 18DCPEP03" is replaced by "Web Programming Lab - 19DCPEP03". The following core paper contents are revised and coded as Data Structures and C Programming - 18DCPC102 as 19DCPC102, Data Structure using C Lab - 18DCPCP01 as 19DCPCP01, Database Management System - 18DCPC204 as 19DCPC204 and the elective paper Internet of Things - 18DCPE231 as 19DCPE231.

UG & PG - The OBE based curriculum is designed for III and IV semester of UG and PG students to be admitted during the academic year 2019-20 and onwards. Resolved to follow the revised syllabi for PG Core Papers XV and XVII - E-Commerce and Advertising Management respectively in Semester IV for the students admitted during the academic year 2019-20 and onwards.

Resolved to follow the revised syllabus for UG Core Paper IX - Corporate Accounting I in semester IV for the students admitted during the academic year 2019-20 and onwards.

BIOCHEMISTRY:

UG - OBE pattern is framed for the Syllabi and Scheme of Examination for B.Sc. Biochemistry Courses offered in semester III & IV for the students to be admitted during the Academic year 2019-20 and onwards.

In Core Paper III: Enzyme and Enzyme Technology for III Semester, the following topics are included. In Unit II: Pyruvate dehydrogenase in Multi-enzyme Complex, in Unit III: Cofactors Mg, Mn, Fe & Zn, Mechanism of action of Chymotrypsin, in Unit IV: Physical, chemical, encapsulation and entrapment methods in immobilization techniques & Deletion of Lipase, Biotin and TH₄ in Coenzymes of Unit III. The topic Synthesis and degradation of Unsaturated fatty acids in Core Paper IV: Intermediary Metabolism for IV Semester had been removed. Ethical Hacking in Unit V of Allied II: MS-Office 2010 for IV Semester is included.

PGI - The Scheme of Examination and Syllabus [Semesters III & IV] under OBE pattern is implemented for students admitted during the Academic Year 2019-20 and onwards. Inclusion of MOOCs for extra credits. B.Voc. Food Processing Technology are included under the eligibility for the admission of M.Sc., Food and Nutrition.

Based on the feedback given by the students and the

practical difficulties faced by the faculty members who are handling the course, it is recommended to revise the syllabi for the students admitted during the academic year 2018-2019 and onwards.

* Further the pre-discussion for courses of V and VI semesters under OBE pattern for the students admitted during the academic year 2018-2019 and onwards is carried out and the following suggestions were given:

✓ Spoken Engineering (18CSUC511/08CAUC511/15ITUC306) and Software Testing (16CSUC613) can be combined as One Course.

✓ Probable courses for Skill Based Subjects are Python, PHP-MySQL, Software Testing Tool, Data Analytics using Spreadsheet, Weka, Scilab, LaTeX, etc.
