The following resolutions are passed:

1. Under CBCS pattern, for the UG students the total marks and credits are 4000 and 40 respectively. and for the PG students the total marks and credits are 2200 and 90 respectively. If the marks/credits for both of the readmitted students are different in any paper, the student has to reappear for the examination and she may be treated as student with arrears under special category.
2. For the students who were admitted for the year 2007 under autonomy, when they are readmitted after the introduction of CBCS pattern they are to be considered as 2007-2010 batch and provided with 3600 marks and 120 credits with the existing register number.

3. The final year UG/PG students with only one arrears in any semester are eligible to appear for supplementary examination.

4. Regarding the revaluation, between the first and second valuation, if the difference of marks is more than eleven (11) <sup>of 100 marks</sup> the paper will be valued for third time and the <sup>average of two nearest marks will be</sup> final valuation is taken in to consideration.

2. Single Valuation for PG courses with 50% internal and 50% external examiners be introduced with effect from April/May 2010 onwards. The PG students be allowed to apply for revaluation / re totalling / providing 2<sup>nd</sup> copy.

3. Remuneration to clerical assistants for practical examinations:

- i) Eligible DA has to be provided for internal / skilled / non-teaching staff during holidays and vacations.
- ii) Rs. 35 is to be paid to the clerical staff for every hundred candidates per day.
- iii) Rs. 25 is to be paid to scavenger / sweeper per day.

4. Extra credit (apart from the prescribed total credits of the course) <sup>scored</sup> by the students need not be shown in the consolidated Mark statement.

5. The question papers for practical examinations shall be set by the internal and external examiners jointly for which they are eligible for a remuneration of Rs. 100 (for one set) and Rs. 60 per set if more than one set of question papers are prepared, to be divided equally by both the examiners, <sup>with effect from</sup> November 2010 onwards.

6. The time table for the end semester (April 2010) is placed before the examination committee and the same is approved.

7. Central valuation will begin soon after the completion of each part.

2. Candidates of PG Examination are eligible to apply for **retotalling** only and not for **reevaluation**/xerox copy of valued answer scripts.
3. Revised mark Statement will be issued after withdrawing the previous one, if the marks obtained in **reevaluation**/re-totalling are higher than the marks awarded earlier.

A student should get a minimum pass mark in all the papers offered in a branch of study and earn at least the minimum number of credits (90/140 credits) to get her PG degree.
