Sericulture plays an important role in economic development of rural sector and the sericulture industry also provides employment opportunities in rural and semi urban areas. To gain in depth knowledge in this field and to impact practical skill a hands on training programme on silkworm rearing was arranged for the students on 06.09.2019 at Sekar Serifarm Athani, Erode District under DBT Star Scheme. Er. A.K. Chandrasekaran, Proprietor, Sekar Serifarm, Athani detailed about the stages of silkworm rearing, care to be taken, factors essential for the silkworm development, the quality of mulberry leaves for the silkworm health and the materials necessary for sericulture. He also explained about the range of temperature, humidity, light intensity etc., and also about the protection of the young larva from ants and lizards. Next, the students visited "Late age rearing centre" owned by Mr. Palanisamy, Agriculturist, Athani. He explained about the care and skill required for silkworm rearing, which is the important factor for getting the best quality cocoon and also to increase the quantity.

He also articulated about the cross ventilation facilities, clean environment, reduction of contamination, spread of disease, appropriate time for mounting the silkworm larvae and also about rotary mountage of Late age silkworm rearing. Through this visit, students were exposed to practical skill in sericulture and also the financial aspects for establishing silkworm rearing and silk production units. 2 staff members and 22 students from different disciplines were benefitted by this programme.

#### Report

Biological Science is promoted with conservation of animals and plants in an era of the biodiversity depletion. To train up the teaching and non teaching members on the maintenance of museum, a Two Day Faculty Development Programme on "Preservation and Maintenance of Biological Specimens" was organized on 24,09,19 & 25,09,19 under DBT-Star College scheme. The programme started with a prayer song, Dr. D. Indumathi, Head of the Department welcomed the gathering and introduced the resource persons, Mr. D. Balaraman, Taxidermist, Officer Grade-I, Government museum, Chennai and Mrs. B. Jency, Curator, Government museum, Frode to the audience, The Principal, Dr. N. Maragatham, offered her felicitation.

During the technical session I, Mr.D. Balaraman explained about the wet preservation technique. He highlighted the preservation problems related to wet mount like evaporation, discoloration, leakage and deterioration of specimens and how to rectify them. He also gave the protocol for the preparation of preservative solutions for specimens. The resource person also demonstrated the dry mount using crab and Bird's egg. The participants individually practiced both the wet and dry mount techniques using egg, crab and sankara fish and displayed their preparations.

In technical session II, Mrs. B. Jency gave guidance to various stages in bone and belief preservation technique like boiling, degreasing, drying, bleaching and installation.

She also explained the procedure for skinning and stuffing of birds and re-adjusting of broken feathers and preservation of plumage.

On 25.09.2019, the sessions were held at Government museum, Erode. Mr. D. Balaraman detailed the methods of labeling the specimens as per the taxonomic position. Mrs. B. Jency gave an overview on safety measures while labeling, preserving the biological specimens. She explained about the systematized repositories of biological specimens. The importance of slide mounting like initial fixation, maceration, dehydration staining, clearing and final mounting were demonstrated by the resource persons. The interaction with the resource persons has enriched the knowledge of participants on various preservative techniques. Thirty one participants got benefitted by acquiring practical skill in specimen mount, preservation and maintenance.

The importance of biodiversity conservation through specimen maintenance and refurbishment was inculcated among the participants through this programme.

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

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

#### **Brief report of the Programme**

The Department of Nutrition and Dietetics, Vellalar College for Women, organized a one day workshop on "A Pragmatic Approach to International Cuisines" on 24/10/2019. Dr.S.Deena, Vice Principal & Director, Catering Science and Hotel Management, Sri Ramakrishna College of Arts and Science, Coimbatore, acted as a resource person and delivered lecture on Chinese and Italian cuisine. The session geared up with a Chinese saying, "Eating is a necessity but cooking is an art".

The extraordinary sensory attributes of Chinese cuisine lies on the addition of distinctive ingredients (green onion, ginger, garlic, aniseed, peppercorn, dry red pepper, white pepper powder, soybean sauce, light/dark soy sauce and vinegar). Further, the uniqueness of the recipe relies on the usage of cooking utensils namely, wok, wok shovel/ladle, Chinese scoop strainer, long chopsticks, rice cooker, pressure cooker, bamboo steaming baskets and cleaver. The most famous Chinese dishes viz., sweet sour chicken or pork, spring rolls, fried shrimps and cashew, chow mein, dumplings, egg fried rice, spicy tofu and wonton soup were highlighted in the session. Every year, February 13 is celebrated as "National Eat Italian Food Day". The most iconic foods consumed in Italy are pizza, risotto, lasagna, truffles and gelato. Pizza was designed during 18th century. The most common ingredients used in the Italian recipes are wine, pasta, olive oil, garlic, rosemary, capers, lemon, porcini mushrooms, basil, polenta and tomatoes. The utensils used in making Italian dishes are pasta pot, garlic press, grater and colander. Chef G.Shankar, Assistant Professor, Catering Science and Hotel Management, Sri Ramakrishna College of Arts and Science, Coimbatore, demonstrated few cuisines of Chinese

- Sweet corn egg drop soup, Mediterranean
- Greek salad, Italian Macroni cheese sauce, Srilankan Vattalappam and Mexican Grilled chicken Quesadillas.



This method focuses on understanding the process and concepts of science, rather than memorizing facts. Teachers were trained to use (RBPTs) in their regular classrooms, in order to improve critical thinking and research skills among students. It encouraged teachers to explore alternative methods of pedagogy and make undergraduate science education more learner-centric.

Level 1 Three-day Regional level workshop. A team of 5 Trainers who were trained by a team of experts from UK and also certified by Centre of Excellence in Science and Mathematics Education (CoESME) and IISER Pune provided training to all participants on all three days.



#### Session: "Proposal writing and Funding Agencies"



The aim of this workshop is to create awareness and kindle the interest among students about the space science and astronomy.

#### One day National workshop on Astronomy: From Concept to Observation

One day National workshop was inaugurated on 06.02.2020 by Our Secretary Thiru. S. D. Chandrasekar and felicitated by our madam Principal Dr. N. Maragatham. Dr. P. Anitha, Assistant Professor of Physics, welcomed the gathering. Totally 700 participants including 137 outside participants from various colleges have attended the workshop. Dr. M. Yogeswari, Assistant Professor of Physics, proposed the vote of thanks.

Technical Session I: This Fascinating Astronomy - Dr. V. Anand B.Sc., MDS., Professor & Head (Amateur astronomer), Department of Dentistry, Meenakshi Medical College Hospital & Research Institute, Kanchipuram has acted as a resource person. He started his talk with the quotes from Paul Davis "Upon this Earth I have Small treasure of Room". Then he explained about Borties scale of sky. He briefed about various types of binoculars, telescopes and their limitations. He emphasis that how Saturn rings are constantly changing its width and how the constellations have to be identified. Finally he attracted the attention of the participants by showingsome interesting astronomical pictures.



One day workshop on "Basis in Microbiological techniques" was organized by the department on 19.02.2020 under DBT star college scheme. The purpose of the programme is to introduce the basic principles and applications of microbiology and to familiarize the skills and techniques involved in it. Dr.D.Indumathi, Head of the Department of Zoology welcomed the gathering.

In the technical sessions-I, the resource person Dr.M.Elayarajan, Associate Professor, Water Technology Centre, TNAU, Coimbatore gave a presentation on the topic "Identification and Analysis of Soil Microorganism." He explained about the types of soil microbes, role in the decomposition of organic matter, recycle of nutrients, plant growth and also about the change in microbe population due to soil pollution. He demonstrated the dilution procedure, soil bacteria culture and identification methods to the participants.

Technical session-II was handled by Mr.K.V.Pradeepkumar, Manager, Guru Enviro Tech, Chinniyampalayam, Erode on the topic "Preparation of microbial solution for sewage treatment." He explained about the economic importance and industrial application of bacteria. He demonstrated the microbial solution preparation for solid and liquid waste management, pest control and soil health management and to eliminate odour in the poultry industry. He showed the bacterial strains used in the preparation, formula for starter culture

and mass culture and field application. The students learned the procedure for microbial solution preparation.Dr.V.S.Kavitha, Associate Professor of Zoology proposed the vote of thanks.

Practical work not only promotes experimental learning but it also encourages self learning and makes student independent and increases confidence level. The workshop familiarized the basic techniques in microbe identification, culture and application of them in various fields. The students were motivated towards career and research opportunities in the field of applied microbiology.

#### **REPORT**

A Research Committee is functioning in the College to co-ordinate and support the research initiatives of the students and faculty. "Research Scholars Circle" was initiated in the Institutionon 27.02.2020 to augment the quality of the research. The Research Conclave and Research Scholars Circle jointly organized **six** days "Madame Curie Webinar Initiative – SERIES - II" from 06.11.2020 to 12.11.2020.

The webinar titled "Exploiting Digital Information for Current Research" commenced on 6<sup>th</sup> November 2020. The resource person,Dr. Pit. Pichappan, Senior Scientist, Digital Information Research Labs, Chennai, hasthe credit of being a Guest Professor of Zhejiang University, China initiated the webinar series. Topics covered in this webinar include a method of tracking information digitally for research, searching techniques and research information from journal articles from the researcher's perspective. The invited speaker also detailed some major lists of libraries for e-resources. Searching techniques like Google Search and Academic Search are briefed. He gave insights about Springer, Science Direct, PubMed and Database maintenance. Presentation includes issues and challenges on the utilization of information and dark web page. The session concluded with a discussion between the speaker and participants on digital information for current research. The session was completed at around 4:30 p.m.

The webinar titled "Basics of Statistical tools" was the second session conducted on 7<sup>th</sup> November 2020. A welcome address was given by Dr. V. Sreeja, Assistant professor, Department of Chemistry. The session was handled by Dr. R. Parvathi, Associate Professor and

Head, Department of Mathematics, Vellalar College for Women, Erode. The lecture started with a motivational speech. She has provided a very clear presentation regarding different tools in statistics like measures of central tendency, measures of dispersions, correlation and regression. She explained various aspects of research methodology like the framework of hypothesis, data collection, data analysis, sampling procedure, etc. She also discussed the tools applied to various disciplines. Finally, the session ends with a mutual discussion.

The program for the Third day (9.11.2020) began as per the schedule with the prayer song. The well-organized team of the English Department elegantly led the program. The welcome note was given by Miss. M. Sivamani followed by the introduction of chief guest Dr. S. Akila, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science, Vellalar College for Women, Erode. The first and foremost instruction of the speaker was to record the findings of the researchers. The popular research writing tools such as Google Scholar, Grammarly, Ginger, Smallseotools and their usage were explained with detailed PowerPoint slides. To improve the language and to rectify the grammatical errors, two powerful tools Grammarly and Ginger application usage was demonstrated by the speaker to the research scholars. The installation of software for grammar check was vividly picturized to the listeners. Finally, the most important topic of discussion was onPlagiarism Check and the clarification regarding the topic was given importance by the speaker. Then the program came to an end with the discussion session followed by the vote of thanks. With 103 participants, the program was very successful and productive.

The webinar titled "An Overview of Indian Banking Sector & Opportunities in it" was the third session conducted on **10.11. 2020**. The resource person **Mr.C. K. M.Soundar**, Senior Manager, Axis Bank, Coimbatore who has a banking career of almost 10 years, presented the basic Banking structure and its functioning along with the emerging trends in banking practices. He also highlighted the opportunities in the Banking sector and gave valuable insights on the online economic transactions initiated through private-owned applications. The programme saw a participation of **57** members from various streams and ended with the active interaction, queries effectively answered by the speaker.

The resource person for the Fifth session on 11.11.2020wasDr. R. Parvathi, Associate Professor and Head, Department of Mathematics, Vellalar College for Women, Erode. In her speech on "SPSS for Researchers", she discussed the advanced analysis and inference writing on

each aspect. She gave training on how to use SPSS software. Also, how to perform analysis in SPSS and writing interpretation according to our results were discussed. She also shared various tips regarding publishing papers in SCI-indexed journals and aspects to be improved by the scholars while they prefer to publish a paper in those journals. **53 members** participated and got benefited.

The Sixth session on **12.11.2020** was titled "Get Rid of Thorns from your Doctoral Journey". **Mrs. V.
