


REPORT






Breast cancer awareness is a movement that aims to increase awareness and reduce the stigma linked to the symptoms and treatment of breast cancer. Many cancers are treatable when detected early. Screening looks for early signs of cancer or precancerous conditions before any symptoms appear.
