# APICULTURE TECHNIQUES

Collecting honey from wild bee colonies is one of the most ancient human activities. The Enviro-club student volunteers have participated in this programme. Mr. A. Dhandayuthapani, Trainer of ADP Apiary has trained the enviro club students on honey bee culture techniques and maintenance of honey bee colonies. He also explained about the three castes of bee in colonies. 1. aqueen bee, which is normally the only breeding female in the colony 2. a large number of female worker bees, typically 30,000-50,000 in number 3. a number of male drones, ranging from thousands in a strong hive in spring to very few during dearth or cold season. He also demonstrated about "smoker" a device designed to generate smoke from the incomplete combustion of various fuels. He also narrated the future prospects of apiculture which is thought to be very simple but a complicated business and eco-friendly technology which can contribute positively and increases the agricultural production. This programme was an eye opener to the students to become Enterpreneurs. About 100 Enviro club students have attended the session.








