EXTENSION ACTIVITY (2019 – 2020)



Brief report of the programme

Forest biological diversity is a term that referring to all life forms found within forested areas and the ecological roles performed by them. Forest biological diversity encompasses not just trees, but the inclusive of plants, animals and micro-organisms that inhabit forest areas.

Many Plants and animals dwell beneath the forest canopy which is a home to large variety of invertebrates, bacteria and fungi, that play an essential role in cycling nutrients in the soil and the forest soil were affected by the plastic wastes thrown into forest by passers and tourists, Hence it's important to preserve the forest from the deposition of plastic wastes .

As a part of Extension activity, Department of Biochemistry conducted a Forest cleaning activity at Sathyamangalam Tiger Reserve, Dhimbam on 29.07.19. About 21 students of III.B.Sc.Biochemistry rendered their service to clean the forest and removed plastic wastes from the forest.

15. Distribution of Mask and Hand Sanitiser


